

Presbytery of Santa Fe Cuba Special Offering 2018

\$15,000 Goal

The Cuba Work Group recommends that the majority of the offering be sent to the synod to be used as determined by the church leaders in Cuba, and a portion to support the seminary. The following projects are identified as needing support, but no amount will be specifically allocated. Churches within the Presbytery of Santa Fe who have partner churches in Cuba may designate 50% of their offering to their partner church.

Synod support

(This money would be used for pastors transportation and other needs as they arise. PSF is the only Presbyterian Reformed Church of Cuba (PRCC) synod partner other than the partnership with the denomination, PC(USA).)

Matanzas Seminary

(Funds would support the seminary students, specifically for transportation to assigned churches.)

CANIP

Support for the construction projects at the Synod Camp and Conference Center

Congregational mission projects

(Local congregations of the Presbyterian Reformed Church of Cuba are reaching out to their communities providing breakfast, lunch, laundry services, clean water projects.)

The Cuba Work Group has refrained from setting the offering date since any Sunday that is agreeable for the congregation is best. Members of the Cuba Work Group are available to promote this offering. You may contact Susan Keil Smith at susankeil1246@gmail.com
